They get their puppies from reputable breeders or rescue shelters and their training lasts three years. It is intensive training where the puppies are with a student, continually going in buses, classes, labs, shopping, etc. They are then placed with a candidate who works with the trainers for several months. This service is provided through U of I and there is no charge to the new owner.
